Invest in enhanced health care equipment and services in Airdrie

The Airdrie Health Foundation began after five-year-old Lane suddenly became ill at night. With the absence of 24-hour emergency care in Airdrie, Lane's parents were not able to access the help they needed to save their son. A year later the family was in need of medical care once again for one of their children in the middle of the night. This time they made a dangerous trip to Didsbury Hospital in a massive snowstorm. This led the Bates family on a journey to prevent other families from such tragedies.

The Airdrie Health Foundation started as a grassroots group advocating for enhanced health care in Airdrie in January 2010 and became a charity in 2014. The AHF now supports much needed equipment, supports programs and education.

Funds are also raised to support high priority health care needs such as:

- Creation of Lane's Room to help take off the stigma around mental health. A room in Urgent Care was renovated to offer a less clinical, calmer atmosphere for patients in mental health crisis and renamed Lane's Room.
- **Syringe Pump** that more effectively administer medication to pediatric patients
- **Pregnancy & Beyond Program** that supports new moms and babies in their first year
- and more!

The Airdrie Health Foundation engages with all levels of government and Alberta Health Services as a strong community voice seeking a hospital to be built in Airdrie.
